

# Service Flash

Service is one of the seven fundamental areas of the Australian Guide Program. The service given in these challenges must be above and beyond what is normally done or expected at home (i.e. normal household chores, like feeding pets, making your bed, washing the dishes), school, or in Guiding.

Service given for each level may include up to three different types of service. Service given to Service Flash 2 and 3 must be above and beyond service given to previous challenges. The service given to these challenges can be cross-credited to the Junior BP and BP Awards.

The badges will only be available in cloth, and can be worn on the sash, with each badge sitting next to the previous (if gained) with no gaps between the badges.

## Service Flash 1

To be started at a minimum age of 7 years. A minimum of nine hours of regular service over three months (approximately 40 minutes per week) to be given. This can include service to your family and/or school.



## Service Flash 2

To be started at a minimum age of 9 years. A minimum of fifteen hours of regular service over three months (approximately 1¼ hours per week) to be given. This can include service to your immediate and extended family, school and Guiding.



## Service Flash 3

To be started at a minimum age of 12 years. A minimum of twenty-one hours of regular service over three months (approximately 1¾ hours per week) to be given. This can include service to your immediate and extended family, school, Guiding and the community.
